Maths ideas for you at home

This term we will be working on addition and introducing subtraction within the numbers 1-10.

At home if your child is interested in doing sums, don't be tempted to make it too difficult — start with adding/subtracting 1 or 2. It is important that they fully understand this first before moving on to harder sums.

We are going to be focusing on TIME this term. Help your child at home by talking about times of the day e.g. morning, afternoon, evening, night. Ask your child if they know what DAY/MONTH/DATE it is, we do this everyday in school and the children love to follow the calendar!

<u>Dinosaurs</u>


Five enormous dinosaurs Letting out a roar. One ran away, and Then there were four.
